# Featuring Mary Jo Pitzl Presents the legislative wrap-up



Once again (her 6<sup>th</sup> year) Mary Jo Pitzl will present the legislative wrap-up for the 2017 legislative session.

Areas of interest: Legislative and government reporter for The Arizona Republic and AZ central. Mary Jo spends much of her time at the state legislature. She will give an excellent summary of the legislative activities for the past twelve months.

Mary Jo has worked as the legislative and politics reporter at The Arizona Republic since 1980. She has been at The Republic through momentous news events, countless redesigns and numerous editors – and has lived to tell about it.

She has covered numerous beats, from Scottsdale police to universities, Gov. Fife Symington to the environment. Previous watchdog projects have included continuing coverage of the state's budget crisis of 2008-2011, a critical look at new arsenic standards and an examination of the loopholes and exemptions that riddle Arizona's tax code.

A native Nebraskan, she studied at the University of Nebraska and earned degrees in Journalism and French.

Mary Jo lives in central Phoenix and she is the current caretaker for a home in one of Phoenix's historic neighborhoods. When she's not tracking the latest policy debate or traipsing around the statehouse, she enjoys gardening, hiking, singing with a women's community chorus and running a journalism contest that promotes the best work in the western states.

STEP 1: Creating an Online Fry's Account

\*NOTE: If you already have an online Fry's account, skip to #2

\*Go to <a href="http://www.frysfood.com/">http://www.frysfood.com/</a>

\*Select 'Register'.

\*Under Sign-In information, enter your email and create a password. (Write down your email & password—will need it in step 2)

\*Select 'Use Card Number'.

\*Enter your Fry's V.I.P Card Number, last name and postal code.

\*Under 'Select Your Preferred Store' enter your postal code.

\*Select 'Find Stores'.

\*Choose your store then select 'Create Account'.

\*You will then be prompted to check your email for a confirmation email.

Click the hyperlink in your email to finish creating your Online Fry's Account.

\*Continue to step #2 to register for the Fry's Community Rewards Program of your choice.

STEP 2: Register for the Fry's Community Rewards Program

\*Go to <a href="https://www.frysfood.com/topic/community?activePage=community-rewards-2">https://www.frysfood.com/topic/community?activePage=community-rewards-2</a>

\*Select 'Sign-In'.

\*Enter your email and password then select 'sign in'. (This will be the email and password you created in step 1)

\*Select 'My Account then select 'Account Settings' from drop down menu.

\*Click 'edit' under Community Rewards. If prompted, enter personal information.

\*Under Find Your Organization: Enter the NPO number or name of organization then select 'search'. (You can get the NPO number from your organization)

\*Under Select Your Organization: Select box next to your organization

\*Then select 'save changes'\*If you have registered correctly, you should now see your organization information listed under 'Community Rewards' on your Account Summary
