- ◆ Helped establish Channel 8 TV at Arizona State University
- ◆ Helped establish Required Kindergarten in Arizona
- ◆ Broadcast "G.E.D." classes on radio. 1971
- ◆ Developed and broadcast "Survival English" over station KIFN to help Spanish American women living at home and listening to the radio learn a few words and phrases useful in everyday living. 1971
- ◆ Produced and distributed nationwide a prize winning fire safety program called "S.A.F.E.: Safe Adult Fire Evacuation"; a slide/lecture presentation for adults who gather in places of public assembly. 1980
- ◆ Initiated legislation requiring an Accredited School System within the Department of Juvenile Corrections facilities. 1986
- ◆ Continue to work on Gender Equity through Girl Power.
- ◆ "Running and Winning" project for High School Girls. Elected officials help them to consider running for office. 2006-7
- ◆ Established an Endowed Scholarship fund at Phoenix College in 2011.
